Overview

The Student Ministries Summer Staff will seek to support the Student Ministries team. The Summer Staff will come alongside the summer interns to develop and execute curriculum and programming for middle school and high school camps. They will attend assigned camp weeks and assist in running the camp programming. Summer Staff will also assist with College Ministries' weekly gatherings. Summer Staff will report to the Director of Student Ministries.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be involved in the planning and implementation of summer trips including programming, administrating, and leading
- Attend bi-monthly Student Ministries staff meetings
- Meet regularly with High School and Middle School staff
- Support, mentor, and work alongside college interns
- Build and maintain relationships with 6th-12th grade students
- Attend and lead Student Ministry summer events with staff and students
- Help plan and execute College Ministry Chillin' and Grillin' events

OTHER DUTIES

- Occasionally lead the teaching at camp and at events
- College Ministry budget management

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Actively pursuing a relationship with Christ
- Agreement with CPC mission, values, and statement of faith along with ECO's essential tenets
- Leadership skills and abilities
- Ability to engage students in authentic, relational ways
- Experience working with and leading high school and middle school students
- Strong organization, detail-orientation, and multi-tasking skills
- Self-starter, strong work ethic
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office (Outlook, Excel, Word)
- Highly teachable with a desire to be mentored and grow in leadership
- Collaborative working style and ability to work well with a team

PREFERRED REQUIREMENTS

- Relational gifts
- Basic understanding of vocational ministry
- One year post college graduation

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Ability to sit, walk or move about in order to accomplish tasks
- Ability to kneel or stoop to work on projects
- Ability to sit or stand for prolonged periods of time
- Ability to manipulate (lift, carry, move) weights of 10-25 pounds

POSITION REPORTING: The Student Ministries Summer Staff reports to the Director of Student Ministries

HOURS: This is a seasonal and temporary position that runs from May 22 through August 15, 2020. It is a 40+ hours per week position.

COMPENSATION: Stipend, paid out over the course of May 22-August 15, 2020

TRAVEL: This position requires travel to specifically assigned camps, from the list below:

- Rockslide: June 22-26
- Quest: July 6-10
- Summit: August 1-7
- SIX8 serves!: 3 various days throughout the summer
