Jesus Healed Bartimaeus

MARK 10:46-52

Jesus and His disciples came to Jericho. As He went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great crowd of people, a blind beggar named Bartimaeus was sitting by the road.

Bartimaeus heard people saying that Jesus was a Nazarene. He began to call out to Jesus saying, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!”

Many people warned Bartimaeus to be quiet; however, Bartimaeus did not listen to them. He continued to call out, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”

Jesus stopped and asked the people to let Bartimaeus come forward.

The people told Bartimaeus, “Have courage! Get up! He’s calling for you.” Bartimaeus threw off his coat, jumped up, and came to Jesus.

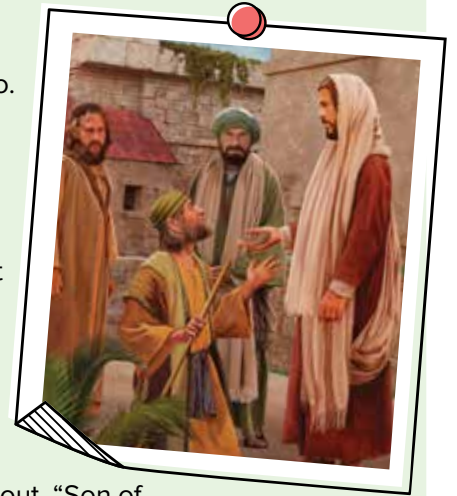
Jesus asked the man, “What do you want Me to do for you?”
